Dear Presidents,

In less than a month, we will meet again in Moscow on June 12 and 13 for the FIFA Congress where, we, the Member Associations, have the power to decide to continue the development of football and promote its values worldwide.

You will choose the host country of the 2026 World Cup, and Morocco, land of football, participate in this competition with serenity, determination and fair play. Morocco 2026 is a responsible, profitable but also respectful Bid for the environment, a Bid proposing an inclusive and human World Cup.

Morocco will host 12 stadiums that meet all the standards and will represent a major turning point in the design of sports venues: modular and sustainable stadiums, designed to ensure an authentic experience and a strong legacy.

Our compact territory, our cultural heritage and the connectivity of our cities provide all federations ideal conditions for players and supporters, but also profits of at least \$ 5 billion (the double of each of the previous editions of the 2014 and 2010 World Cup), guaranteeing FIFA's ability to continue to develop football around the world.

The choice of the host country cannot only be determined by the capacity of a stadium or the economic maturity of a country, but this choice must also take into account the capacity of the World Cup to help promote the social and economic development of a country and a whole continent. The honor of organizing the biggest global sports competition cannot only be reserved for a very small number of countries.

Morocco, a millennial-old country at the crossroads of Africa and Europe, East and West, has been a candidate for the organization of a World Cup for 30 years. This 5<sup>th</sup> attempt, supported by the entire nation, reflects the unwavering desire of our youth to celebrate the king sport and use it as a vehicle for progress and opportunities.

To vote for Morocco is to vote for a Human World Cup, and for an open and multilateral world, fully committed to building a sustainable future for the next generations.

With this at stake, we are writing to you with humility to confirm our commitment and our determination to welcome you in 2026.
